

## **PILGRIM COMMITMENT**

At all times, the "pilgrim's notebook" is handed over against a commitment by the applicant to maintain moral and material conduct respecting the spirit of the pilgrimage, all along his path:

- Respect for others, respect for monuments, respect for sites and the environment
- Respect for the lodgings and the facilities made available, you will of course have to participate in the maintenance and accommodation costs. You must also accept the little annoyances caused by collective life.

The pilgrim associations decline any civil or criminal liability that could result from your conduct. However, the pilgrim's book includes a recognition on our part with the civil and religious authorities, for a possible help on the Way: we are somehow guarantor for you. Be worthy! ...

This "credenziale" is only intended for pilgrims on foot, by bicycle or on horseback who wish to make the pilgrimage in a spiritual process. It gives no rights; it serves two purposes:

- 1 / Access to shelters, pilgrim lodges, sometimes host families who offer hospitality on the way. These reception places are not free: fair participation should be left, even to those who ask for nothing.
- 2 / Obtaining the "TESTIMONIUM" in Rome which is the authentication of the Pilgrimage. You can go to the Petriano entrance from the Sant'Uffizio square (from 9:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.).

It is necessary to respect the regulations of shelters and pilgrim cottages, to demonstrate simplicity, cleanliness, fraternal respect for the well-being of others. Be silent so as not to disturb everyone's rest.
